


## **Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement Financial Year 2019**

At nVent, we are committed to conducting business with absolute integrity, which includes combatting modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chain. As a global company, nVent is committed to complying with all applicable laws and regulations, including the UK Modern Slavery Act.

nVent's Code of Business Conduct and Ethics requires all employees to act with the highest levels of ethics and integrity and to treat others in a fair and equitable manner with zero tolerance for human rights abuses. All employees are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct, which sets clear expectations about ethical behavior and compliance with laws. nVent conducts annual Code of Conduct training and provides multiple ways for employees to ask for help and report misconduct and illegal or unethical behavior including a Helpline available at [www.nVentethics.com](http://www.nVentethics.com). We are committed to investigating and responding to all concerns.

nVent's suppliers are expected to adhere to our Supplier Code of Conduct, updated and consolidated with our Supplier Guide in 2019, which prohibits forced labor, child labor and discrimination. It also prescribes the key principles under which suppliers are required to operate, including compliance with applicable laws regarding human trafficking and slavery. In 2019, nVent updated its new supplier pre-qualification processes to include anti-slavery questions. This process also includes verification against government denied party lists. nVent maintains the right to audit its suppliers with respect to any potential non-conformance with the Supplier Code of Conduct. Additionally, nVent conducted critical supplier audits in 2019, and continues to reserve the right to require corrective action from any supplier and to terminate its business relationships with any nVent supplier who is unwilling or unable to comply with the Supplier Code.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending December 31, 2019.
